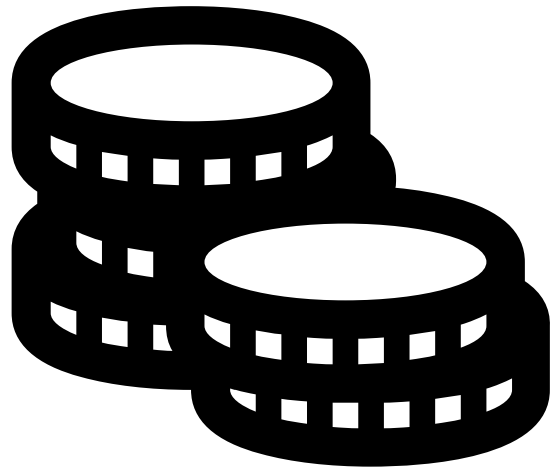

- The Emilia-Romagna Region has a law on Participation since 2010 (l.r. 3/2010) recently repealed and replaced by Law 15/2018.
- The general objective ... is to develop and foster a sense of active citizenship in the choices of public policies, and in particular to important and strategic decisions for a territory, creating a network of information, consultation, listening and involvement among the various actors, in compliance with the principles of transparency, fairness and simplification of administrative action.





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- From 2012 to today an investment of 2.3 million euros for over 800 participatory processes surveyed and 160 projects funded. Since last autumn to January 2019, in addition to approving the new law on Participation, we have carried out two public tenders, one of which is a theme to support bodies involved in activating participatory processes for the revision of their statutes or regulations relating to participation. Another closed in mid-October, the investigation is now underway, and we received as many as 77 projects and in consideration of the budget we have made available will be the tender with the largest number of projects funded ever.

Community of Participatory Practices of the Emilia-Romagna Region

- During 2018, through a process of co-planning with experiential participatory activities based on learning by doing, the community of practices of regional participation operators came to life.

Goals:

- work on facilitation and participatory methods for creative problem solving and participatory project management
- activate a permanent process of innovation and continuous improvement based on listening, involving and enhancing skills

2 cases of participatory processes, good practices and results

General Objective



CO-EVOLVE aims at analyzing and promoting the co-evolution of human activities and natural systems processes in touristic coastal areas, allowing sustainable development of touristic activities based on the principles of ICZM/MSP.

CO-EVOLVE INFODAY – Rimini, 7 November 2017



- Local plans will be co-designed and verified also through the use of some specific participative patterns. The involvement of local communities and the actors on which the plans will have the impact, is intended in defining objectives and actions more suitable, adequate, functionally and responsive to actual needs, and, therefore, more easily reachable.
- For the two pilots scheduled in the current project, different paths are under definition: on the grounds of specific contexts and needs, to which the same methodology will be applied. This will allow to have, at the end of Co-Evolve, two case-studies, with related action plans agreed with the communities and the local stakeholders.



WP4 – Cattolica Pilot Area



- A densely urbanized C&M tourism destination, with beach facilities and a multi-purpose river port (fishing, yachting, shipyards, yacht production, shops) with high waste production and peculiar by each kind of activity
- Phenomena of siltation from upstream and sand accumulation at the port's mouth reduce safety, attractiveness and operability of the port, with strong impacts on the various tourist and economic activities present.
- Periodic dredging operations with a strong impact both on the environment and on the costs that the public administration must support are necessary.

Main results, themes and actions individuated in the local Plan



- ✓ Public/Private collaboration for monitoring and sharing maintenance of the seabed of the port (elements for a P/P Memorandum of Understanding)
- ✓ Sustainable management of the seabed also through innovative solutions (ejectors plant installed in the haulage/launching basin)
- ✓ Feasibility project for installation of ejectors plants in all the critical points of the port seabed
- ✓ Waste collection systems, fishermen, shipyards, marinas, urban, and reduction of waste production in the port area
- ✓ Reduction of river fine sediment load also through the introduction of opportune terrain management measures in the river watershed

An **Action Plan** to be implemented with the collaboration of diverse public and private stakeholders, with specific agreements and memoranda of understanding, for the management, environmental sustainability and re-launch of the Port of Cattolica

POLICY fase



The purpose of this Directive is to establish a framework for the assessment and management of flood risks, aiming at the reduction of the adverse consequences for human health, the environment, cultural heritage and economic activity associated with floods in the Community.



Flood event: Temporary covering by water of land not normally covered by water. This shall include floods from rivers, mountain torrents, Mediterranean ephemeral water courses, and floods from the sea in coastal areas, and may exclude floods from sewerage systems

LEVEL OF INVOLVEMENT

- To engage citizens and stakeholders during all process
- To reach new ideas and proposals
- To create new networks and partnerships
- To train and prepare the general public

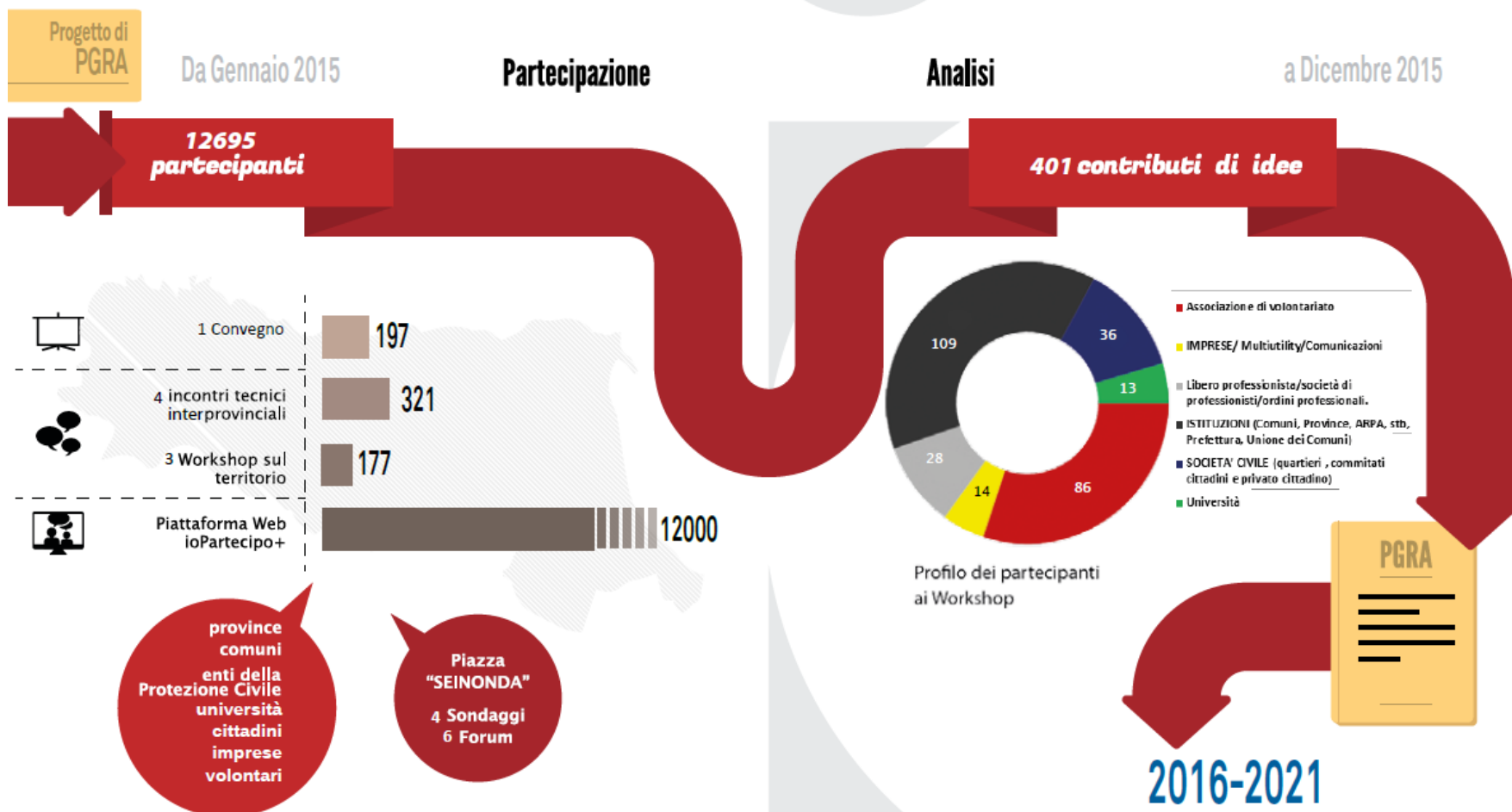

Impacts



- The regional strategy in Flood Risk Management (FRMP) has been re-defined also with the contribution of citizens ideas
- More attention to public involvement in risk management (schools, young people, associations, volunteers, etc)
- Development of new communication channels between public institutions and citizens, especially during emergency situations
- Improvement of the cooperation between different public institutions
- Development of new tools for establishing cooperation between public institutions and citizens in watercourses maintenance

Workshop SEINONDA: new perspective and ideas from European young people

The workshop dedicated to the Emilia-Romagna experience allowed us to illustrate the project as part of the activities of the European Youth Parliament, focusing interventions on actions to be implemented during a flood event and on how to organize a volunteer network in following the occurrence of a calamitous event. The boys were invited to take part in a participatory moment to help develop emergency management models.
